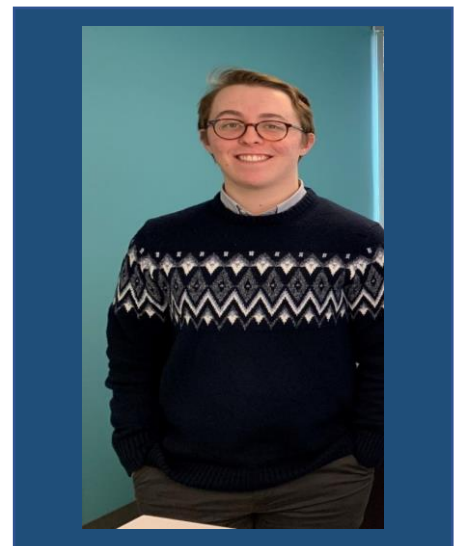
Joey Hermann was an IT Intern with EDSI. Here he shares the experiences, thoughts and insights he gained over the past year.
